**Graded Exercise – With a partner**

Simply read through the code, and demonstrate it working.

1. Agree on a TCP port number with your partner. Choose a high port number (i.e. not in the well-known port number range). Edit both the client and server to reflect your choice.
2. One person runs the server, the other person runs the client.
3. Chat! The chat implementation is simple (e.g. one-at-a-time), so the server must say something first, then client responds, repeat until client says “bye”.

Demonstrate a working chat with a partner before leaving lab to receive credit.
