Lab 4 – Intro to Subversion (SVN)

Non-graded portions

Install an Subversion client on your system (if you don't already have one).

For collaborating with your group, consider using Subclipse <http://subclipse.tigris.org/> , an Eclipse plugin that provides SVN support from within Eclipse.

Graded Exercise – On your own

Simply add a file to your group's repository named after yourself in the format LASTNAME_firstname.txt. Steps (with svn commands):

- Check out your group's repository (with `svn checkout`)
- In that directory, create the file locally. It can be empty.
- Add the file for inclusion (with `svn add`)
- Check the file into the repository (with `svn ci`)

I will simply check for the each student's file, checking the logs to make sure each student checked in his or her own file.

The commands listed above correspond to the svn command line client (you can always use the one on strauss.udel.edu). You might be using a GUI client, which is fine.
